**BURDEKIN debutantes, where art thou?**  
 Last year Burdekin girls Rosanne and Stephania Scuderi were amongst the winners at charity organisation Angel Flight's deb of the year in Townsville.

**But so far this year not a single Burdekin girl is willing to wear their deb dress again for a good cause.**  
 Organiser Gwen Barr said the Burdekin has always been very supportive of Angel Flight and hopes the girls will again lend a hand.

**The deb of the year night, held at Southbank in Townsville, gives the girls another chance to wear what are often very expensive dresses, Ms Barr said.**  
 "For the deb of the year they have the opportunity to wear their dress again, they cost Mum a lot of money. It's different from a deb of the year, we have the presentation and a show.

**"The Burdekin always does have their own deb of the year. We've always had entrants from the Burdekin, but this year not one.**  
 "You can't beat country areas as far as as putting on events like this. They are very supportive."

**Unlike the perception, Ms Barr said the entrants don't have to raise a lot of money for Angel Flight.**  
 "All the deb's have been sent an invitation. All they need to do is raise \$200."

**For the first time there is a talent show held in conjunction with Angel Flight, she said.**  
 "If they think they have talent, sing, dance whatever, there is the opportunity to win a trip to Brisbane."

 The prize is a trip to Brisbane and the Gold Coast to perform at multi award winning venues with Queensland Entertainer of the Year Deana Peher.

**Ms Barr has sent invitations to all the Burdekin's deb's and is urging the girls to have a go.**
